Dr. Robinson has had the joy and honor of working as a nurse, a licensed professional counselor, and a psychologist. While pursuing her PhD at the University of Houston, she worked at the Brain Injury Research Center at The Institute of Rehabilitation and Research. She taught at Midwestern State University and in their Study Abroad Program in London, England at Queen Mary University. While working in a private psychiatric hospital, she specialized in PTSD and trauma work when working on a military unit. She then worked for all 4 branches of the military as a contractor. She currently is a “train the trainer” and consultant for the Catholic Diocese of Fort Worth for Child Sexual Abuse and Sex Trafficking. She is an ambassador for Shared Hope International, a nonprofit organization combatting Human Trafficking for almost 23 years now. She works part time with Ranch Hands Rescue, a sanctuary for humans and animals who have experienced trauma. It offers trauma informed therapies geared towards meeting the needs of trauma victims and will open the first safe house for male survivors of sex trafficking between the ages of 18 and 25 in May of this year.
