Confirmation Check List for the Celebration

Parish Liturgical Coordinator! Please follow this check list and have everything ready before Bishop and MC (Master Ceremony) arrive:

Liturgy of the Word

- 1. Lectionary with selected readings of first and second (*if Sunday then the reading is in the parish lectionary according to cycle year. If selected from Confirmation List, it will be in Ritual Votive Common Volume*).
- Book of the Gospel with marking the Gospel (If weekday celebration, <u>the Bishop has</u> <u>selected Matthew 25:14-30 (33rd Ordinary Time) for 2025 Confirmation</u>; if Sunday, Solemnity, or Feast then use from that celebration).
- 3. **Print out 2 copies of the Intercessions** that are attached in the Liturgical Form and put it in a liturgical binder.

Ritual of Confirmation

- 1. Have Oil of Chrism and a Bowl ready with few purificators.
- 2. Have Bread, Lemon, and Water for Bishop's Washing after Confirmation
- 3. Have name tag of Confirmation Name for Bishop to call them. If chose other route, please clear out before Mass with MC of celebration.
- 4. Rehearse with candidates to respond with (Amen & And with your spirit) when celebrating Confirmation.
- 5. If more than 15 candidates, do not process in but should be seating before mass with their sponsors.
- 6. Please organize immediately after Mass for ONLY group picture with Bishop, Bishop may have individual family picture, please check with MC or Bishop before celebration.

Liturgy of the Eucharist

- 1. Have Roman Missal mark according to the Liturgical Form (*If Sunday follows the Sunday with Collect/Offering/after Communion. Preface according to Seasonal Sunday. If selected Confirmation Ritual, please refer to Roman Missal pages 977-981*)
- 2. Setup for Mass with extra Bowl & Pitcher Water for Washing of Bishop's Hands after Anointing
- 3. Have Altar Holder for the Roman Missal.

Liturgical Ministers

- 1. Train readers when to come up for readings
- 2. Review music with Musician especially the Penitential Act. Have musician ready to play as soon as Bishop's Part of the Mass is ended. Do not have a dead space in the mass.
- 3. Train Altar Servers when approach Bishop must bow their heads.

Condition of the Church

- 1. Make sure the Church is cooling down an hour before Mass.
- 2. Have a cold bottled water for Bishop at the end of celebration.
