**What is the March for Life?**

The march is a peaceful, prayerful gathering of pro-life people. Participants will start at the Washington Monument and walk up Constitution Ave. and end at the Supreme Court Building. Most of the marchers are Catholic and youth. Our March is an outward sign of our prayer that abortion will no longer be legal in our nation and that each human life will be treated with dignity and respect.

**It's more than a March it's a Pilgrimage!**

Our pilgrimage will include, prayer (the Divine Office, Rosary, Divine Mercy, Adoration), daily Mass, confession, visiting holy sites, interaction with people from DC and across the nation, educational experiences such as visiting museums such as the National Holocaust Museum, and discussion and fellowship each night. **Who can go on this pilgrimage?**

Any and all young adults (18-35 years old). Married couples and families within this age range are also welcome to join.

**How much does it cost to go?**

The cost of the pilgrimage is \$450.00 per pilgrim. This covers all expenses for the pilgrimage (transportation, food, lodging, fees, etc.). Upon registration, you will be asked to make a non-refundable deposit to hold your spot and airfare of \$250.00. The remaining \$200.00 you will bring with you the day of the pilgrimage.
